



## **Budget Category Definitions:**

Member Dues – Amount collected per pay period for each employee member.

<u>Per Capita – Cupe National</u> – Amount that Local 387 pays based on the number of full time and part time employees to CUPE National.

<u>Affiliations</u> – These are all groups that local 387 is a member of and the amount we contribute to continue accessing the benefits delivered by those affiliations

<u>Salaries</u> – This covers the salary and benefits of the regular full time officer and the part time office staff.

Office – Any upgrades to the office that are not part of the building (ie: furniture, shelving, wall art....)

Executive – The honorariums that the executive members each receive each month

<u>Bargaining</u> – Expenses related to any bargaining the union conducts. This can include staff time to attend meetings, printing of documents, room rentals, supplies, etc...

<u>Grievances</u> – This includes legal fees for arbitration and any other expenses related to a member grievance.

<u>Conventions/Conferences</u> – Conventions are a requirement for members to attend as part of union business. This includes staff time, travel, accommodations, if required, etc. Conferences, although not a requirement, are beneficial for members to attend and are offered based on the union's needs.

<u>Education</u> – Educational courses are offered by different affiliations and are beneficial to members and often a requirement for the executive committee. This includes the cost of the courses and staff leave of absences and other expenses involved with attending a course.

<u>Donations & Contributions</u> – CUPE 387 has some standing donations each year and take into consideration any requests that come from within the City of New Westminster.

<u>Events</u> – Any events that the public relations committee organizes for the members. This includes, Christmas, golf, curling, softball, etc...

<u>Committee Expenses</u> – The union has several different committees that require members to meet and this can involve staff leave of absences and other expenses related to the operation of the committee.

<u>Holdings Society</u> – Local 387 owns their own office and there are expenses related to the operation of the office, such as strata fees, property taxes, legal fees and renovations.

<u>Operating Expenses</u> – This involves all the day to day expenses that come up such as office supplies, electricity bills, cell phone bills, internet, etc. This also includes welfare gifts/flowers for members and the retirement payouts to the members based on years of service.
